Every day I also keep myself abreast of new web design methodology and best practices using several blog sites. I act as web consultant for both marketing departments.

- I created and installed an improved navigation interface for tnbcad.com client center (now [clientcenter.tnbcad.com](http://clientcenter.tnbcad.com) since the purchase of TNB Card Services by Fifth Third Processing Solutions) using css flyout menus that resulted in easier site navigation for all clients.

Each client sees their logo or banner when they connect to the website, and all rate and disclosure info comes from a centralized source. This replaced an older website and saved hours of update work then being performed by the website administrator.
